### •Background Of Cattleana Ranch

Founded in 1993, Cattleana Ranch is one of the first environmentally sustainable all grass and hay beef cattle grazing operations in Wisconsin. We bring to you clover-finished beef, free-range chickens, pastured pork and lamb.

Our beef animals enjoy a serene, peaceful life on lush green pastures of clover and grass at Cattleana Ranch. They are not stressed by the competition of feedlot operations or force fed grain. In the winter months the cattle continue to enjoy their stockpiled grass and hay that is retained from the growing season. The result is a great flavor with many health benefits. Our pastured chickens are lean and flavorful birds. The chickens are raised only during the summer months on Cattleana's pastures. After leaving the brooder, they are placed in movable pens that are moved throughout the pasture. In addition to the grass and bugs, they a custom feed mix.

The summer pigs live on pasture at a partner farm near Berlin, Wisconsin. They have regular access to a specially planted pasture so they stay clean and healthy. The pastured pigs eat a large amount of green growing grass, peas, and root crops, and enjoy digging, and romping. This definitely improves the quality of the meat and the quality of the animal's life.

A local farm partner produces the lamb offered by Cattleana Ranch. The lamb sold by Cattleana Ranch is raised during the summer on a natural diet of ewes' milk and pasture. The result is a flavorful, healthy product. Is this different from commercial lamb? YES, commercial lambs are fed inexpensive and unnatural "feedstuff" – from restaurant waste to poultry litter.

Meat from animals raised on pasture have more vitamin E and stay fresher longer, most likely because of the increased level of antioxidants.

### All of Cattleana Ranch's meats are naturally raised, having no added hormones, steroids, or antibiotics.
